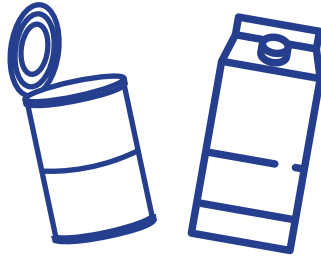


MMSM LESSON PLAN

WORD SEARCH



Introduction

This word search is a fun way to get students thinking about recycling and the environment and familiarize themselves with the words and phrases associated with these topics.

Grade Level

Activity 1 – Early years, grades 1-3

Activity 2 – Middle years, grades 4-6

Thinking Concepts and Skills

- Students will familiarize themselves with different keywords and phrases commonly used when talking about recycling and the environment.
- Use attention to detail to look for letters and patterns to form words.



Activate

1. Pair this activity with discussions about recycling, environment, and the earth to further enhance students' understanding of keywords.
2. Ask students if any words in the search are unfamiliar to them and discuss what they mean.
3. Visit the Recyclepedia to learn what items can and can't go into the blue bins at home.

Acquire

Print off the activity sheets for the appropriate grade.

Apply

Distribute the activity sheets to students.



Extension Activities

1. Discuss the words and phrases found in the word search. What do these words mean in the context of recycling and the environment?
